Dear Sir,-

It is desired to make a special effort to recruit additional pupils for the Brandon and Elkhorn industrial schools. The Department is aware that there are a number of children, probably 30, on the Fisher River and Peguis Indian reserves who would be better placed in residential schools, and I have to ask you to be good enough to take immediate steps to have these children collected and sent to Brandon and Elkhorn.

This is likely to be a hard winter for the Indians and they should realize that they can provide for a certain number of their children comfortably by sending them to these schools. You may make arrangements for transportation for them and have a responsible person accompany both contingents; this will be at the expense of the Department. I hope you will be able to arrange this
