Ottawa. July 12th.1919.

Sir:-

I have to inform you that it has been decided to build a side-walk 6 feet in width extending from the Presbytery down to the Post Office on the Reserve at Betsiamits.

It is desired that you should arrange that the Indians take out during the coming winter a sufficient number of long logs which after being flatted on one side can be used as stringers to carry the planking.

The material for the covering is estimated at 8000 f.b.m. of 2 inch plank and you should make immediate inquiry from parties who are in a position to supply this material as to the price per f.b.m. they would charge for placing this planking on the ground.

Kindly report the result of your inquiries as soon as possible.
