6. (a) Approval was granted for the relocalization of:

ADMINISTRATION

7. (a) Leave - Coal Miners - An additional 79 Army personnel (51 in Eastern Canada and 28 in Western Canada) were released for six months to return to the coal-mining industry.
- (b) Army Rejections for Non Medical Reasons - Rejection certificates, MFM 12 or MFM 141 will be issued to GS or NRMA personnel if in the opinion of the Army Examiner they are unlikely to become trained soldiers for reasons of illiteracy, etc. OCs Depot have been given authority to sign these certificates on the advice of the Army Examiner.
- (c) Absence without Leave and Desertion - Suggestions were made that OCs investigate soldiers' problems and complaints and offer assistance and advice in order to reduce the number of AWLs and desertions. Unit returns should show the man days of absence.
