- (e) Omaha beach heavy resistance encountered at 1135 but operation proceeding.
- (f) Utah beeach. Ahieved tactical surprise.

 Shore batteries under control but not silenced by 0822. Operation proceeding according to plan.
- (2) NCETF reported at 1028 that operation was going well.

 Battleships bombarding Havre. Weather improving.

 Little or no enemy air opposition.
- (3) Mines less prevalent than anticipated. First reports were that ETF cut 7 mines and WTF one mine. No mines found by WTF in shore of lowering area.
- (4) Follow up and build convoys now moving according to plan.
