I am glad to know that you have had a move which at least would appear to be in the right direction.

I really feel that your best plan would be to write quite personally, privately and confidentially to Letson, whom you know, and who would not misunderstand your motive. He might mistake mine were I to have a word with him and, certaintly, he would pass on my word to other officers at headquarters, some one or more of whom would begin to exaggerate the whole situation. I am quite clear in my own mind that any representation so far as you your behalf would be of doubtful value, so far as you yourself are concerned, and almost certainly would react against myself.
