2. The remarks contained therein have been brought to the attention of the Officers concerned. With respect to Para 3 of your letter. The Proceedings were confirmed by The District Officer Commanding on the 27th June, 1942, and were forwarded to the Commandant, Petawawa Military Camp on the same date. They were returned from Petawawa by letter dated 30th June, 1942, to this Headquarters, arriving here on 1st July, 1942, but it appeared that the Proceedings had not been promulgated and that the documents had been forwarded to this Headquarters in error. Consequently, they were returned again on 1st July, 1942, for promulgation. They were duly promulgated and returned to this Headquarters by letter dated 9th July, 1942, arriving here on 11th July, 1942.

3. The Proceedings were not considered complete and they were returned to Petawawa on the 13th July, 1942 and finally arrived back here on the 19th July, 1942. The responsible Officer at this Headquarters was leaving for special duty the following day and was gone from this Headquarters several days, and on his return, and as soon as possible, the Proceedings were forwarded for registration and custody.
