talk & one of them bought us a round. There was a girl there, talked & drank till about 9:30, got up & talked to girl & she asked for a picture. I showed her one & she grabbed it. We then left with Pte St George, Pierre & Paquette. Took a tram to 4th & bought ticket to stop before center food & walked back. Ticket cost 3d. Arrived in camp about 12 o'clock. In my hut I charged pants. Put Grenier's pants on back near his bed. When woke up he asked me if I saw wallet & I said "no". That is all.

Cross-exam - nil

Court - I had my own wallet in the pub, it is brown wallet, with zipper on 2 sides, the zipper is broke. my 2 10/- notes were in this wallet with all these small papers. I took this wallet out of my pocket on the street on the way to the pub. I did not take wallet out of my pocket in the pub. Only thing I took out in the pub was this folder of pictures. On the street I took the money from my wallet & put in my pocket.

1st Wit for prosecution Pte St Georges, A. recalled at request of def offr: - will swear oath he is examined by the court:-

On the sidewalk on the way to the pub Cpl Legace took a wallet (his wallet) from his pocket & sd he had £1 to drink. We were talking about how much money we had. We sat at small round table. There were 2 red caps sitting near us - they talked just to the Cpl then they talked with the rest of the gang. On the table we had bottles of light ale & our glasses, also cigs. Did not see any wallet on the table at any time.

Defence closed.

Prosecutor's closing address: Case of theft. Review evidence.  
Submits prosecution.

Def. offr on closing: - First statements taken 26 Sep. - offence alleged 1st of Aug - nearly a month after. In meantime wallet has disappeared. why should there be such a delay, seeing Rochleau's statement stress his good memory for details. Identity card issued in 1940. Rochleau says old wallet of 1½ yrs wear, under closer exam in what state was identity card. Identification of wallet as Grenier's only circumstantial. In summary Grenier says wallet contained no pocket of himself. Delay has left room for much thought. suggest Rochleau not worthy of belief, details given by this witness more specific than given by the owner. Rochleau says zipper around 2 sides & cover says around 2 sides. Any wallet similar was shown on street. Rochleau confounding examination on the street when asserting the amount of money he had. Amount of money spent corroborates that which they say. Cpl Legace sd he had 22/- when he was going & spent only 1/- afternoon. suggests evidence for prosecution to be colored, due to delay, arts and be found not guilty.

Judge Advocate sums up - points out definition of theft, credibility of witnesses; burden of proof on prosecution; reasonable doubt.
