Indian Reserve,

Nov. 4th, 1946

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Lower Kootenay Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at Creston, in the Kootenay Indian Agency, in the Province of British Columbia at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 4th day of November, A.D. 1946, in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of the said Reserve, ~~request that a sum of money be paid out of the money standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of~~ agree to the transfer from the Band of 60 acres of Reserve #4, said 60 acres being the west portion of the 66 acres now leased to Arthur Petersen; to be divided in equal portions to Lazarus Louie, Louie Ernest, Isaac F. Basil and Stanislaus Simon, all members of the Lower Kootenay Band.
