



**CIVIC WATER-WORKS AND ELECTRIC LIGHT STATION**

Occupying the site of the "Old Red Queen's Warehouse," some of the foundation cribs of which remain. The dressed stone trimming at bottom of brick-work of water tower was taken from the Strong Box defence in the old Commissariat Building.



**MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Erected in 1885-6. Destroyed by fire, and rebuilt 1889. The original Town Hall and Market Square were on Dalhousie Street, at foot of Murray street. The lot was a gift to the citizens of Amherstburg from the Crown, including the Murray street dock property.
