August.—It is not often that anything can be said in favor of weeds but for the smart weed much may be said. It is almost a sure remedy against colic. Steep and drink the same as any other herb tea. We mention it here to say that it is worth five dollars a hundred for a stock of cattle, if it is cut and cured when in full bloom. Give an ox, cow or horse one pound per week during the time they are feeding on dry hay, and it will keep their bowels and hide loose. It is an excellent physic for horses, and they will be kept clear of bots and worms by giving them one pound a week of smart weed. It has been stated that horses will eat it sooner than the best of hay. As, however, we recommend it only as medicine, we prefer to give it when deemed necessary.
