The annual statement of business was quite satisfactory. In the life department, up to July 1st—just two years from the date of its organization—the whole number of policies issued was 4415. In the accident department, the whole number of policies issued in four years and a quarter exceeds 130,000. The entire income of the Company for the year ending July 1st, 1891, was \$810,013.67, of which amount \$599,003.51 was for premiums on accident policies. Losses paid on fatal and non-fatal accidents within the year, \$223,303.50; total losses paid since commencement, over \$800,000. The accident business shows a handsome gain, for the part six months, over the corresponding months of last year. It has not only been entirely self-sustaining, maintaining at all times a surplus more than sufficient for re-insurance, independent of the capital, but has divided ten per cent. to stockholders within the year, leaving the accumulations of the life department untouched.

In regard to the life business, the number of policies written in the first two years sufficiently indicates the popularity of the Low Rate Cash Plan. The total assets of the Travelers now amount to \$1,059,003.24.
