LIEUT.-OOL. D. WYLIE.

A Brief Sketch of the Life of Canada's Oldest Journalist.

One of the beat known and most respected citizens of Brockville is Lieut.-Col. David Wylie, whose portrait we herewith present. Col. Wylie was born in the year 1816, in the village of Johnstown, in the abbey parish of Paisley, Scotland. In his childhood he was a great lover of literature, and eagerly devoured all the books from which he could gain instruction or amusement. He was particularly fond of the pootry of his country is so famous. At the age of ten the boy David was apprenticed to a printer in Paisley for seven years. His master going out of business before the expiration of that period, his indefiture was transferred to the University printing office, Glesgow, Being of a studious habit, he commenced the study of Latin, Greek, and shorthand, while in his apprenticeship, and afterwards became proficient in each of these branches of learning. In 1845, at the carnest solicition of Mr. J. C Beckett, the well known publisher, Mr. Wylic came to Canada, and for four years remained in his employ, for four years remained in his employ, it his writing being in favor of responsible government, which was then a burning question. In 1849 he went on the staff of the Montreal Herald, as parliamentary reporter, and while acting in this capacity distinguished him ealf by the feat of reporting eighteen columns of a debate which followed the lawring of the prediament, build.
