In the course of a debate on Canada's currency in the House the other day Hon. Mr. Fielding gave the following interesting explanations and statistics:

Mr. Fielding said there were two systems of savings banks, the Government savings banks and the posteffice banks. The policy of the Government was to close the former as fast as possible and turn the business over to the postoffice banks.

There was a supplementary vote of \$25,000 for printing Deminion notes, bringing the total vote for the year ending June 30, 1905, up to \$135,000.

Mr. Fielding explained that this was

necessary owing to the expanse of cir-oulation and to the policy entered upon last year of giving the people clean money in the Government not circula-tion. Last year eight million old and

dirty Dominion notes were retired and replace by new ones. These were in the denominations of one, two and four. The appearance of the four-dollar bill had been changed so as to prevent its

being mistaken for a one-dollar bill

The roll of the control of the Columbia of the Dominion notes was shown in the following figures: 1890, \$16,000,000; 1895, \$15,000,000; 1903, \$25,000,000; April 30, 1905, \$47,-925,000.

Numbering the Hairs.

The number of individual hairs that cover the human scalp is greatly a mat ter of speculation; but it is supposed to vary according to the thickness and color of the hair. A well-known auth-ority estimates that red-haired people lossess the fewest, and places the average number at thirty thousand. Black haired persons, on the other hand, are said to run into one hundred thousand; while the fair-haired have the largest number of all—namely, one hundred and fifty thousand. These figures should form a valuable index to those people whose hair is on the down grade. An excessive falling off could be reckoned at from 100 upwards, and by counting the number of hairs they lose each day some idea might be formed as to new long they are likely to be before they are overtaken with total haldness Hairs which fall out, however, are not always a "total loss." They often grow again from the root.

World's Most Ancient Ruins.

The oldest architectural ruins in the world are believed to be the rock-cut temples at Ipsambool, on the left bank of the Nile, in Nubia. The largest of these ancient temples contains four-teen apartments, hewn out of solid stone. The largest single stone used in this work is one which forms a veranda-like projection along one side of the main temple. It is fifty-seven feet long, fifty-two broad, and seventeen account says nineteen-feet thick. This colossal stone is supported by two rows of massive square pillars, four in each row and each thirty feet high. To each of these pillars is attached a colossal figure of a human being, reaching from flow for row. from floor to roof. In front of the main temple are seated still other col-ossi, four in number, the two largest being each sixty-five feet high. The ruins are supposed to be 4,000 years old.


