SYNOPSIS OF COAL MINING REGULATIONS

Coal mining rights of the Dominion
in Yukon, British Columbia and Al-
berta, the Yukon Territory, the
North-West Territories and in a por-
tion of the Province of British Co-
lumbia, may be leased for a term of
twenty-one years renewable for a fur-
ther term of 21 years at an annual
rental of \$1 an acre. Not more than
3,500 acres will be leased to one
applicant.

Application for a lease must be
made by the applicant in person to
the Agent or sub-agent of the dis-
trict in which the rights applied for
are situated.

In surveyed territory the land must
be described by sections, or legal sub-
divisions of sections, and in un-
surveyed territory the tract applied for
shall be staked out by the applicant
himself.

Each application must be accom-
panied by a fee of \$5 which will be
refunded if the rights applied for are
not available, but not otherwise. A
royalty shall be paid on the men-
surable output of the mine at the
rate of five cents per ton.

The person operating the mine
shall furnish the Agent with sworn
returns accounting for the full quan-
tity of merchantable coal mined and
pay the royalty thereon. If the coal
mining rights are not being operated,
such returns should be furnished at
least once a year.

This lease will include the coal
mining rights only, recorded by
Chap. 27 of 4-5 George V. assented
to 12th June, 1913.

For full information, application
should be made to the Secretary of
the Department of the Interior, Ot-
tawa, or to any Agent or Sub-Agent
of the Dominion Lands.
