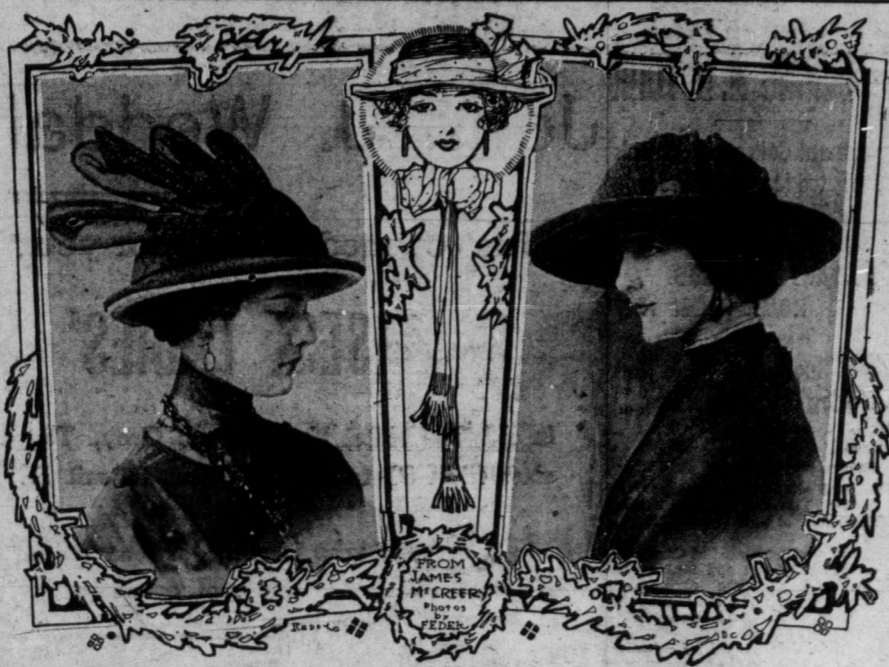


A BEAUTIFUL BABY

When the Valiant paid her second visit to Rabat, the Bey was inclined to be communicative. As a matter of fact, the news of the Nila Moulah's disastrous fight with the Evil One spread so rapidly that it reached the seaboard within a fortnight, whereas the prophet's journey in the reverse direction took three weeks. Other items filtered through the Atlas passes and finally there came a man who was actually in Lektawa at the time of the dread combat. He it was who first gave definite assurance that Warden lived. When the ruler of that disturbed city had slain every individual overtly opposed to him, and the remaining inhabitants were meditating on the divine right of kings, it occurred to someone that the Nazarene and Beni Kallil were missing.
