New York and other American cities will be visited by the traffic chiefs, as well as London and Paris. It is planned to establish a signal system of some kind at the most congested street intersections.

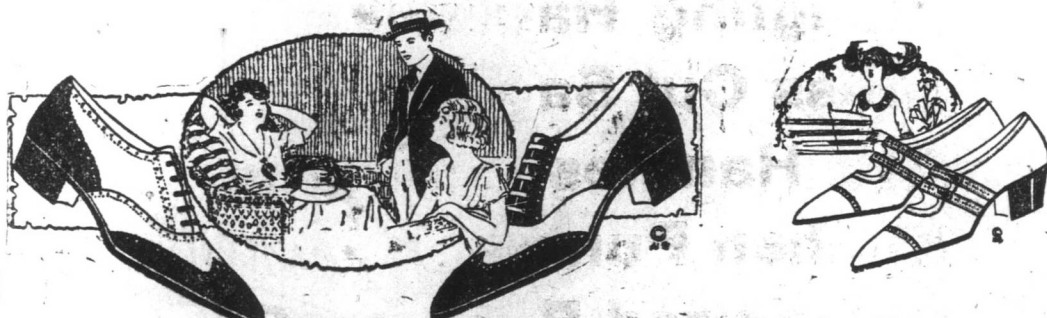
### Locusts Invade Mexico

### French Detective Lands His Criminal

AFTER LONG CHASE.

PARIS.—(A.P.)—This is the story of a Paris detective who travelled half way around the world for his quarry, and finally, in the dense jungle of Annam, threw aside his disguise and arrested his man, who is now doing three years in jail.

As related here an antiquary named Malraux was under the observation of the Paris police, suspected of being responsible for some recent thefts from French museums. It was also thought he had designs on collections of antiques in one of the French provinces, and as a matter of routine a detective was assigned to trail Malraux and a companion, wherever they might go.

The pair went to a seaport and there took passage on a steamer for Saigon, French Indo-China, and the detective went along on the same vessel. He did not even have time to buy a change of clothing, but made friends among the crew and borrowed what he needed.

At Saigon Malraux and his friend posed as rich travellers, anxious to see the country, while the detective slouched around in the background. He had, however, made known his mission to the local French authorities, and when Malraux asked for guides to the remote districts of Annam, the detective was among the natives assigned, but cleverly disguised. The party scoured the region of Angkor, rich in holy relics and fine specimens of old Chinese art, and Malraux and his companion bought freely. Also they did not hesitate, conditions being favorable, to burglarize Annamite temples for particularly fine specimens.

The border of Siam was not far away, and the collectors, having decided to leave the country by that route, called up the native guides and dismissed them. Then the detective had his day. The humble disguise was cast aside, the French policeman stepped out, and Malraux and his friend were placed under arrest.

The case was tried at Phnom-penh, Cochinchina, and Malraux had no defence. It came out, during the trial, that his antiques were destined for New York antiquary, and were worth 1,000,000 francs.

### Sun Yat-Sen Party

Again Declares Its Pro-Foreign Policy.

Canton, China, Aug. 4. (A.P.)—The Kuomintang, the party of Dr. Sun Yat-Sen, president of the South China republic, took advantage of the recent strike of house boys at Shanghai, the foreign settlement of Canton, to reiterate the party's pro-foreign policy. In a statement given out by Dr. C. C. Wu, son of the late Wu Ting-fang, one time minister to Washington, the Kuomintang refuses to entertain an alleged proposal of certain Shanghai members of the party to rescind the party's order refraining from anti-foreignism.

A new and stronger order was in fact issued. This reads: "It is the duty of this party to make China a really independent and sovereign state on the basis of the party's three principles. It regards all narrow and anti-foreign sentiments as harmful to society and the world at large, and detrimental to the complete independence and equality of the Chinese state and race. For this reason the party has always strongly exerted itself in suppressing such tendencies."

The pronouncement asserts that even during the Manchu uprising of 1900, when the Manchus were inciting the Boxers in their "insane movement to destroy the foreigner" the Kuomintang, which had started a revolution at Wuchow, accorded protection to foreign life and property. Since then the revolutionaries, whenever they took up arms, never failed to take special care to give adequate protection to foreigners.

The northern militarists on the other hand, Dr. Wu's statement continues, "having usurped the Peking government, have not hesitated to work in league with the imperialistic powers, and to sell the country in order to further their selfish aims. Our people have often denounced their slavishness towards foreign powers, but the minds of the militarists and reactionaries are really suffused with medieval and monarchial notions and superstitions which are closely associated with anti-sentiments. While in their conduct they are servile, in their mentality they are really hostile to foreigners."

### Adrift for Many Years

A cask has just been picked up in the Arctic Ocean off Cape Bathurst, on the Canadian coast which, if it could speak, would have a curious story to tell.

It was set adrift nearly 25 years ago with 33 others in the Behring Strait between Alaska and Siberia. There was a theory of a great current from the Pacific to the Atlantic, entering the Arctic seas by the strait washing the northern shores of Canada and Greenland and Spitzbergen. 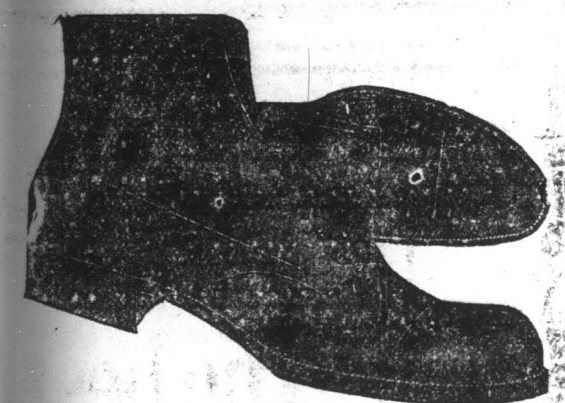

### Setting the Spark Lever

On most automobile engines having spark advance, the spark lever should be set about half to three-

quarters of the way to the top of the quadrant for normal driving. Thereafter the automatic advance, incorporated in the ignition system, will control the spark position.
