LOOK FOR DROP IN PRICE OF POTATOES

Vegetables Chief Officer on Local Market.

Potatoes now selling at 75 cents the bag, by the load, and from 90 cents to \$1 in bag lots, are due for reductions in price during the coming weeks, according to veteran market officials. A price of 75 cents a bag by the middle of April or earlier is being predicted, in view of the fact that large quantities stored for higher prices during the winter will be thrown on the market within the coming fortnight.

Spring onions at two large bundles for 15 cents were the day's most pungent market offering and probably the best buy. Root vegetables of all kinds were offered for sale and splendid gains in large quantities were obtained by those who visit the market on its ordinary slack days.

Marble syrup offerings were scarce to-day, but farmers report a fine flow of sap after the week-end's cold snap followed by a rainy day.

For the rest of this week fresh maple syrup will be offered in increasing quantities, culminating in the Saturday market.

Onions remain firm, at \$1.50, and no change is reported in the price of other grains. Live and Saturday's quotations.

Improvement in county roads is bringing many farmers to town with increasing quantities of surplus stocks, which will bring down prices in several lines that have been more or less scarce during the winter.

Flowers, hothouse grown, made a touch of spring color in the truck produce. Some honey was offered for sale, and one vendor offered fine bunches of plump radishes, rose red and white, against a background of crisp green tops.
