REICHSTAG TO GET **REVALUATION BILLS.** Obligations Totaling 70 Billion Marks Would Shrink to $3\frac{1}{2}$ Billions. BY JOSEPH SHAPLEN. From the New York Herald-Tribune's Berlin Bureau. Copyright, 1925, New York Tribune BERLIN, March 26 .- Plans fo ettlement of Germany's most burn. ing internal economic problem-re-valuation into gold marks of war and pre-war loans now in terms extinct marks-were announced the Government to-day in bills t be presented immediately or vocation of the Reichstag. These would convert obligations, whic originally totaled 70,000,000,00 which originally marks, into a debt of \$3,500,000,000 gold marks. The announcement is of interest o American and other foreign in-vestors in German Bonds, dating from the war and inflation period, even though the revaluation proposed is limited. The bills would revise all the old national, state and municipal loans to equal five per cent. of their orig-inal face value. That is to say, the holder of bonds of a nominal value of 1,000 marks would receive a new Bond for 50 marks. 
