If not she must go before the enumerator on one of ten days before the election and make a statutory declaration of qualification. The enumerator must state, in a notice attached to the lists, where he is to be found and at what time of day for two hours consecutively every day for 10 days before the election and all day election day.

In rural constituencies the enumerators shall prepare the list from the revised provincial lists of 1916, which in turn are based upon municipal rolls. There the duty of the enumerators in the main particulars will be to remove the names of those who are disfranchised as enemy aliens and to add to the lists the names of the women relatives of soldiers who are to receive the vote.




