

Well Remembered that the first day of the first month called March
In the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven (Eight) I George
Ashbridge of Chester in the County of Chester and Province of Pennsylvania German being
somewhat weak and indisposed in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks
be given unto God therefore and calling to mind the uncertainty of this life it being
appointed for all men once to die I have made and ordain this my last will and testament
in manner and form following (that is to say)

From I give and devise unto my son Joseph Ashbridge all that Mesuago and Tenement
where John Drell situate in Chester aforesaid with the Lots or parcels of land
thereunto Belonging which I purchased of James Logan and the Grannor or
Baker house with the Lot of Land thereunto belonging which I lately purchased
of John Yeates and George M. Call with the appurtenances and all those several
pieces of ground which was lately the Estate of John Wards deceased containing
about forty acres I hold to him the said Joseph Ashbridge his heirs and assigns
for ever

From I give and Bequeath by way of legacy unto my Daughter Elizabeth Sharpleff the
Wife of John Sharpleff the sum of forty pounds lawfull money of the said Province
to be paid by my Executors hereafter named at the expiration of one year after
my decease

From I give and Bequeath unto my Granddaughter Mary Sharpleff the Daughter of the
said John Sharpleff and Elizabeth his wife the Chest of Drawers in the Room where
I Lodge

From I give and bequeath by way of legacy unto my Daughter Hannah Hoopes the wife
of John Hoopes the sum of forty pounds lawfull money of the said Province to be paid
by my Executors hereafter named at the expiration of one year after my decease

From I give and bequeath by way of Legacy unto my Granddaughter Mary Exnall
Daughter of Amos Exnall and Mary his wife late dated the sum of forty pounds
lawfull money of the said Province to be paid by my Ex^{rs} hereafter named when
she arrives at the age of eighteen years but if she die before she arrive to
aforesaid Age and not having lawfull Issue then my will is that the said money be
equally divided amongst all her Brothers Sherris and Sherris
