ARTICLE X NOTIFICATION

No person shall be entitled to the privileges and immunities accorded in Articles VIII and IX unless and until the name and status of such person shall have been duly notified to the Secretary of State for External Affairs of Canada.

ARTICLE XI

CANADIAN CITIZENS AND PERMANENT RESIDENTS

- 1. Notwithstanding Article VIII, a member of the Council who is a citizen or a permanent resident of Canada shall not enjoy any privileges, and shall enjoy only immunity from legal process in respect of words spoken or written and of all acts performed by him in his official capacity.
 - 2. An official of the Commission or an Executive Director of the Secretariat who is a Canadian citizen or a person admitted to Canada for permanent residence as defined by applicable Canadian immigration legislation shall enjoy only those privileges and immunities set forth in paragraph 1 (a), (c), and (d) of Article IX.

ARTICLE XII EMPLOYMENT OF DEPENDENTS

Dependents of officials or of the Executive Director will receive authorization to accept employment in Canada. "Dependents" means (a) spouses; (b) unmarried dependent children under 21 or under 25 if in full-time attendance at a post-secondary educational institution; and (c) unmarried children who are incapable of self-support.
