

- (4) to forward proof thereof, and
- (5) in addition to the foregoing general obligations, to furnish such information in respect of the said employees as may be relevant for the administration and operation of the Canada Pension Plan, provided that the provisions of such information is not contrary to German regulations.

ARTICLE IV

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany agrees that the employment of persons at its official missions and posts in Quebec shall be included in pensionable employment under the Quebec Pension Plan and the Regulations made thereunder and in force from time to time; the employment listed in the Annex to the present Agreement shall be excepted from such pensionable employment.

ARTICLE V

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany undertakes, in accordance with the provisions of the Quebec Pension Plan and in respect of its employees included in pensionable employment pursuant to Article 4

- (1) to make deductions from their contributory salaries and wages,
- (2) to pay contributions as the employer of such employees,
- (3) to remit to the Government of Quebec the said deductions and contributions,
- (4) to forward proof thereof, and
- (5) in addition to the foregoing general obligations to furnish such information in respect of the said employees as may be relevant for the administration and operation of the Quebec Pension Plan, provided that the provision of such information is not contrary to German regulations.

ARTICLE VI

The Government of Canada agrees to include by Regulation under the Canada Pension Plan, the employment of persons at official missions and posts of the Federal Republic of Germany in Canada as pensionable employment for the duration of the present Agreement; the employment listed in the Annex to the present Agreement shall be excepted from such pensionable employment. The said Annex shall constitute an integral part of the present Agreement.

ARTICLE VII

The present Agreement may be amended at any time by mutual agreement.

ARTICLE VIII

The present Agreement shall also apply to Land Berlin provided that the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany has not made a contrary declaration to the Government of Canada within three months of the entry into force of the present agreement.
