

ROBERT ELLIOTT

Mr. Elliott was born in Regina, Saskatchewan on August 4, 1928. He studied at the University of Saskatchewan where he obtained his B.A. From 1949 to 1951, he worked for Radio Station CFQC in Saskatoon. In 1952, he joined the United Kingdom Colonial Service serving in London and Nigeria.

Mr. Elliott joined the Department of External Affairs in 1956 and served at the Canadian diplomatic mission in Beirut from 1957 to 1960. From 1963 to 1967, he served at the Canadian High Commission in London. In 1967, he was posted to the Canadian diplomatic mission in Lagos as Counsellor. Upon his return to Ottawa in 1969, Mr. Elliott became the Head of the Middle East Division. In 1972, Mr. Elliott was selected to participate in the Bicultural Program in Quebec City.
