Record of private bills. A <u>record</u> shall be kept in the private bills office of the name, description, and place of residence of the parties applying for a <u>private</u> bill or of their agent, the amount of fees paid, and all the proceedings thereon, from the time of the deposit of the bill with the Clerk of the House to the passing of the bill; such <u>record</u> to specify briefly each proceeding in the House or in any committee to which the bill or the petition may be referred, and the day on which the committee is appointed to sit; such <u>record</u> shall be open to public inspection during office hours.
