SECTION VII.

EXHIBITIONS.

1. There shall be an Annual Exhibition of Paintings, Sculptures, Engravings and Designs in which all Artists of distinguished merit shall be permitted to exhibit their works. It shall continue open to the public for a term which shall be at the discretion of the Council, and be under the Regulations expressed in the Byelaws of the Society.

- 2. No Copy with the exception of Paintings in Enamel and Engravings which have not been elsewhere publicly exhibited shall be admitted into the Exhibition.
- 3. No needlework, Artificial Flowers, cut paper, shellwork, models in coloured wax, or any such performances shall be admitted into the Exhibition of the Canadian Academy.
