SERVIANS CLAIM TO HAVE RETAKEN BELGRADE

LONDON, Dec. 14.—The Servians, after a terrific combat with the Austrians, have re-entered and re-occupied Belgrade, according to the report of a news agency. A considerable portion of the city is said to have been destroyed. It was occupied by the Austrians on December 2.

The Austrians occupied Belgrade Dec. 2, after having besieged it since July 29, bombarding from batteries near Semlin and from monitors on the Danube. A large portion of the city was said to have been destroyed by the fire of the Austrians.

When war was declared, the Servian Government moved from Belgrade to Kraguyevats, and later went farther south to Nish, where it remains at present.

SALISBURY, Eng., Dec. 14.—Orders were issued from the headquarters of the Canadian camp today, that no leave would be granted to the men after the first of January, thus giving rise to the belief that the force will leave for the front next month.
