

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 11.

An Act respecting New Orleans and Grand Isle Traction, Light and Power Company, Limited, and to change its name to "New Orleans and Grand Isle Railway, Light and Power Company, Limited."

WHEREAS New Orleans and Grand Island Traction, Light and Power Company, Limited, has by its petition represented that it is incorporated under *The Companies Act*, chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes, 1906, and has prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 10 **1.** The name of the said company, hereinafter called "the Company," is changed to "New Orleans and Grand Isle Railway, Light and Power Company, Limited," but such change of name shall not in any way impair, alter or affect the rights or liabilities of the Company, nor in any way
15 affect any suit or proceeding now pending, or judgment existing, either by, or in favour of, or against the Company, which, notwithstanding such change in the name of the Company, may be prosecuted, continued, completed and enforced as if this Act had not been passed.
- 20 **2.** Subject to the laws in force in the United States and with such legislative, governmental, municipal or other authority, concession, license or consent as is necessary, the Company may, within the United States of America, survey, lay out, construct, complete, equip, maintain and operate
25 and extend, remove and change as required, double or single iron or steel railways and branches, side tracks, turn-outs and appurtenances and tramways for the passage of
