THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-15.

An Act for the relief of Georgette Claudy Bercier Brabant.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Georgette Claudy Bercier Brabant, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Joseph Elphege Jean Roger Brabant, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said city, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the twenty-third day of December, A.D. 1954, at the said city, she then being Georgette Claudy Bercier; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence 10 adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be 15 henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes what-soever.
