Support of the Annual Charge of the Government; and that no farther Debts were to be contracted, or Taxes rais d, for that Purpose; professing, that it was not in their Power, or not in their Knowledge, to do it by any other Was and Means, than those which the last Parliament approved of.

These are some of the Answers, which, we are told, these Men give to the Charge which is brought against them without Doors; and to the Pamphlets written against them, as well by Squire Burnett, as others: I make no Observations thereon, having neither Room or Inclination to do it; those who like them not, may resute them, if they think they are able.
