on board their Ships or veffels; And to the end that none of Our Subjects may prefume on board their Ships to wear Our Flags, Jacks and Pendanis, which, according to ancient usage, have been appointed as a diftinction to Qur Ships; or any Flass, lacks, or Pendants, in thape and mixture of Colours to far telembling Ours as not to be safily diffinguified therefrom. We do, with the Advice of Our Privy Council. hereby firifily Charge and Command all Our Subjects what foever, that they do not prefume to wear in any of their Ships on Veff-1s, Our Jack, commonly, called the Union Jack, nor any Pendants, nor any fuch Colours, as are utually borne by Oar Ships, without particular Warrant for their to doing, from Us, or Our High Admiral of Great Britain or the Commissioners for executing the Office of High Admiral for the Time being: And We do hereby alfo further Command all Our Loving Subjects, that without fuch Warrant as aforefaid, they prefume not to wear on board their Ships or Veffels any Flags, Jacks, Pendants, or Colours, made in unitation of or refembling Ours, or any kind of Pendant whaloever, or any other Eulign, than the Enlign, dele cribed on the fide or margin hereof, which flia'l be worn inflead of the Enfign before this time ulually worn in Merchant flups; faving, that for the better diffinction of fuch Ships as fliall have Commiffion of Letters of Mark or Reprizals against the Enemy, and any other Ships or Veffels which may be employed by the Principal Officers and Commiffioners of Our Navy, the principal Officers of Our Ordnance, the Commifioners for Victualling Our Navy, the Commiffioners for Our Cuftons and Excice, and the Commiffioners for Transportation for Our Service, relating particularly to those Offices. Our Royal Will and Pleafure is, that all fuch Ships as have Commillions of Letters of Mark or Reprizals, fhall, befides the Colours or Enfign hereby appointed to be worn by Merchant Ships, wear a Red Jack with a Union Jack, defcribed in a Canton at the upper corner thereof next the Staff; and that fuch Ships and Veffels as thall be employed for Our Service, by the principal Officers and Commiffioners of Our Navy, the principal Officers of Our Ordnance, the Commissioners for Vietualling our Navy, the Commissioners for Our Customs and Excise, and the Commissioners for Fransportation for Our Service, relating particularly to those Offices, shall wear a Red Jack with a Union Jack in a Canton of the upper couner thereof next the Staff, as aforefaid, and in the other part of the faid Jack, thall be defcribed the Seal ufed in fuch of the respective Offices aforefaid, by which the faid ships and Veffels shall be Employed. And We do firifily Charge and Command that none of Our Loving. Subjects do prefume to wear any of the faid Diffinction Jacks, unlefs they fhall have Commissions of Letters of Mark or Reprizals, or be Employed in Our Service by any, of the before mentioned Officers .- And We hereby require Our High Admiral, and Commiffioners for Executing the Office of High Admiral, the Governors of Our Forts and Caftles, the Officers of Our Cultoms, and the Commanders or Officers of any of Our Ships for the Time being, upon their meeting with, or otherwile observing any Ships or Veffels belonging to any of Our Subjects, neglecting to wear the Enfign hereby appointed to be borne as aforefaid, or wearing any Flag, Pendant, Jack or Enfign, contrary hereunto, whether at Sea or in Port, not only to Seize, or caule to be forthwith Seized fuch Flag, Pendant, Jack or Enfign worn contrary to Our Royal Will and Pleafure herein expressed, but also to return the Names of fuch Ships and Veffels neglecting to wear the Enfign hereby appointed, or wearing any Flag, Pendant, Jack or Enfign, contrary hereunto, together with the Names of their respective Masters or Commanders, unto Our High Admiral or Commissioners for executing the Office of High Admiral or the Judge of Our High Court of Admiralty.
