INCE COULTS TERRIBLE ARRAIGNMENT OF THE LIQUOR TRAFFIC.

Intemperance cuts down youth in its vigor, manhood in its strength, and age in its weakness.

It produces weakness, not strength; sickness, not health; death, not life. It makes wives widows, children orphans, fathers fiends, and all paupers. It feeds rheumatism, nurses gout, welcomes epidemics, invites cholera, imports pestilence, embraces consumption, and covers the land with misery and crime. It genders controversies, fosters quarrels, breeds riots It crowds your penitentiaries, and furnishes victims to the scaffold. It is the blood of the gambler, the element of the burglar, the prop of the highwayman, and the support of the midnight incendiary. It countenances the liar, respects the thief, esteems the blasphemer. It violates obligations, reverences frand, hates love, scorns innocence and virtue.
