
BRYCE MAKES PROTEST

On Behalf of English Owned Railway in Cuba, Objects to Concession. WASHINGTON, Dec. 2,-(Can.

Press.)-Upon representation by Wm. Young, chairman of the board of directors of the Cuban Central Railrectors of the Cuban Central Railroad, an English-owned line, Ambassador Bryce has filed with the state department a protest against the granting of concessions by President Gomez of Cuba to another line which it is proposed to operate on the north coast of the island. The basis of the protest is the allegation that the proposed road would diminish the value of the concession held by the Cuban Central, which is protected by the treaty between the Ue S. and Cuba.
