

TWO ARE CANONIZED

Solemn Ceremonies Mark Event at St. Peter's, Rome.

Rome, May 14.—Solemn ceremonies for the canonization of Gabriel Possenti and Marie Alacoque were held in St. Peter's yesterday. Pope Benedict was carried in the chair of state to the cathedral, being surrounded by a

gorgeous retinue of ecclesiastics, officials of the civil and military courts of the vatican, members of the Sacred College, archbishops, bishops, Roman nobility and general officers of religious orders. Pope Benedict was seated in a throne erected in the Apse behind the high altar and presided the canonization ceremonies by intoning a hymn. After he had pronounced the formula for canonization and inscribed the names of the new saints in the sacred roll, the

pontiff intoned a "te deum" while the bells announced the happy event. Later Pope Benedict celebrated mass, and then, with the same gorgeous procession, returned to his apartments in the vatican.

ANOTHER ATTEMPT IS MADE TO ASSASSINATE TURKISH GRAND VIZIER

London, May 14.—Another attempt was made to assassinate Damad Ferid, Turkish grand vizier, on Thursday, according to a Constantinople dispatch to the Exchange Telegraph Company. The attack occurred at the grand vizier's residence, and was made by a policeman, who fired upon Damad Ferid, but only wounded the latter's armed attendant. The grand vizier's assailant was arrested.

SUSPECT IS ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH NEW YORK BOND THEFTS

Cleveland, Ohio, May 14.—Cleveland detectives early today took into custody a man they claim is wanted in New York in connection with the theft of millions of dollars' worth of Liberty bonds. They refused to divulge the name of the man, but admitted they "were holding a man in connection with the Arnstein case." It is believed the man knows the whereabouts of two alleged leaders in the bond theft plot.
