PARIS, Aug. 7.—Corporal Gouteaubier of the French Light Infantry has been decorated with a military cross by President Poincare for capturing 100 Germans, including two officers, aided only by a single comrade. The curt references to Corporal Gouteaubier's exploit in army papers reads: "For bravery and courage which struck terror into the trenches and shelter of the enemy. With a single comrade he made 100 prisoners, including two officers, whom he took to the rear, and rejoined his post."
