: : : ECLIPSES

In the year 1896 there will be four Eclipses, two of the Sun and two of the Moon. I. An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, February 13th, invisible in N. America. II. A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, February 28th, invisible in N. America; visible generally in Europe, Asia and Africa.

III. A Total Eclipse of the Sun, August 8th, invisible in N. America.

IV. A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, August 22nd, visible in N. America.

MORNING AND EVENING STARS

VENUS is a morning star to July 9th, and an evening star to end of year. MARS is a morning star to December 11th, after wards an evening star. JUPITER is a morning star to January 24th, an evening star to August 11th, and a morning star to end of year. SATURN is a morning star to May 5th, an evening star to November 13th, afterwards a morning star. MERCURY will be a morning star about March 5th, July 3rd and October 24th, and an evening star about January 24th, May 16th and September 13th.

The satellites of JUPITER are not visible from July 14th to Sept. 10th, the planet being too near the sun. MARS will be in opposition to the sun December 10th.


