

TROUBLE AHEAD FOR DEMOCRATS

Mexican Situation and Party Friction Inheritance of Wilson Who Assumes Office in Two Weeks.

NEW YORK, Feb. 15.—No authoritative statement is yet forthcoming as to the cabinet or policy of Woodrow Wilson. A near friend of his said tonight that he hoped for a progressive and strong cabinet and a strong policy; and that instead of the Mexican situation being a danger, it might be the very thing to solidify and cement the Democrats under Wilson.

President Taft is endeavoring to make things as easy as possible for his successor and is carefully avoiding leaving any great burdens at the threshold of the incoming occupant of the White House. He will go to the last extreme to avoid taking a positive stand in the Mexican trouble. He would deem it a great calamity to have to take measures which would make his administration responsible for a war which it could not carry off, but would have to leave to its successor.

A very ugly situation exists among the Democrats in the house. The plain spoken and almost bitter criticism of house leadership by Congressman Fitzgerald last Saturday, followed by the reports of the Democratic caucus that night, revealed the friction in the party. There is trouble in the senate, also, and the Democratic caucus is endeavoring to oust the conservatives.

AFTER REMOUNTS FOR TURK ARMY

Canadian Breeding Bureau Can't Supply Them Because British Government Has First Call.

MONTREAL, P.Q., Feb. 15.—G. H. Browne, of New York, arrived here this week with an order from the British Government for seven thousand cavalry remounts, to be delivered at once. Mr. Browne went to Turkey two months ago to arrange the sale of some torpedo boat destroyers, and while there was commissioned to secure these horses. Returning to the United States on Tuesday last, he found on inquiry that there were not enough mounts in that country to supply the American army requirements.
