On the northern wing of the advance the British have reached Poelcapelle and Gravenstafel and have overrun most of the Gravenstafel Ridge, which juts to the west from Passchendaele-Gibeluvet the South of the Ypres-Roulers railway, the troops are reported to be overlooking the eastern slopes of the main ridge, and in some places to have passed on to the Valley below.
