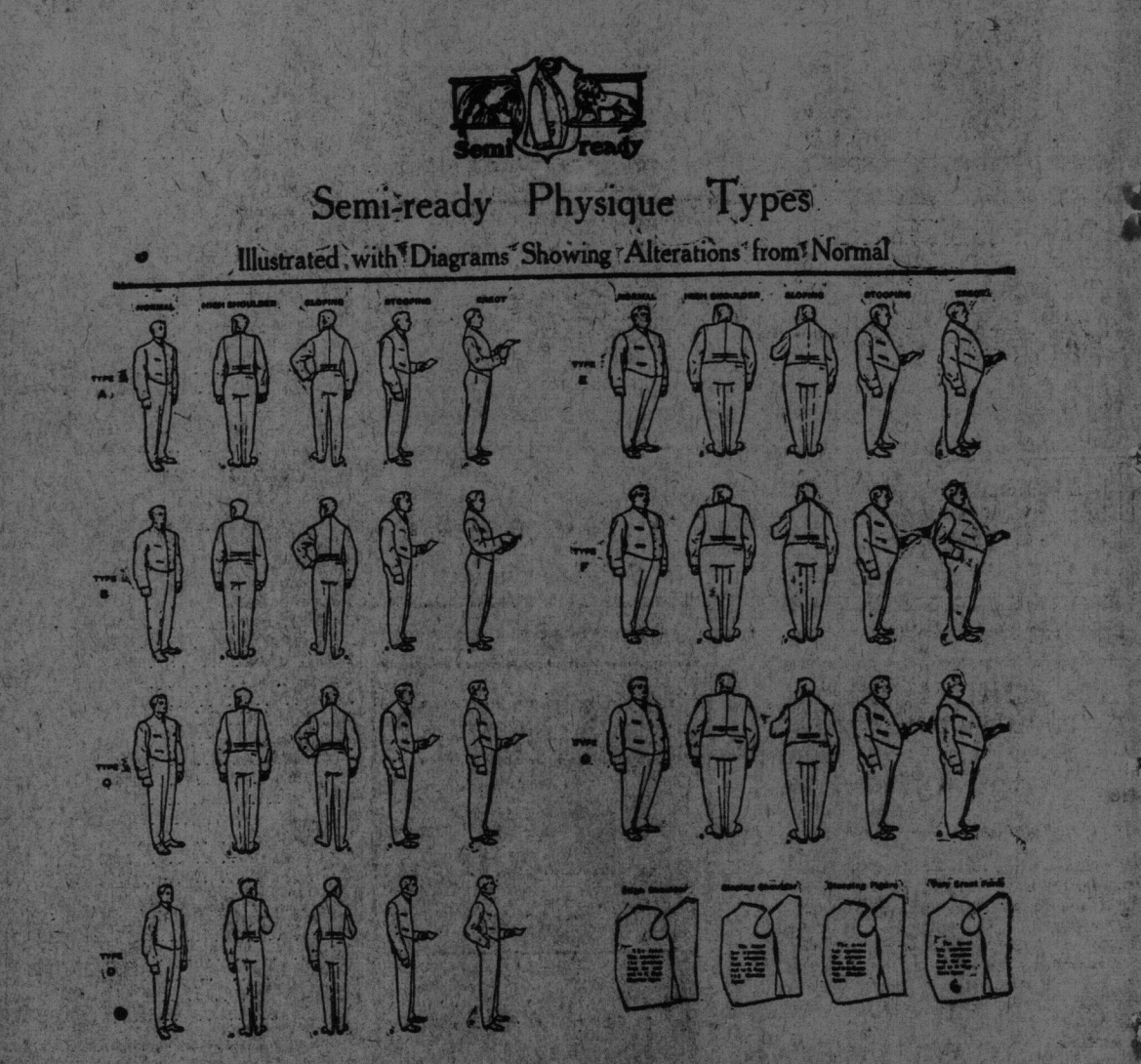

Chief among the new maritime rules and regulations which have been approved by the Dominion government and which shall be enforced on Toronto Bay is one which regulates the lighting system. A green light on the starboard and a red on the port side capable of being seen at a two mile distance will be compulsory. A white light of lesser power must also be displayed at the stern.
