





The Teutonic Order, which must not be infounded with the sovereign Order of John of Jerusalem, commonly known the Knights of Malta, was instituted in 92, by the Crusader King Henry of Jer-alem (afterwards Emperor Henry VI. Germany) after the siege of Acre. Its atutes were framed on the model of loss of the Knights of St. John, and it as decreed that the members should be stricted exclusively to the Teutonic or erman nation, which had sustained great ases at the siege of Acre. Pope Celestine commanded that they hould be styled Knights of Saint Mary, there comes their name of "Mariener-titter," sometimes used in lieu of their nore usual designation, and that they hould be clad in white, and wear a large lack cross on their habits, mantles, tandards and arms. Their first station was at Acre. After the loss of the Holy Land they removed to Venice, and thence to Germany, devoting hemselves to extending the boundaries of Christianity at the expense of the heathen Wends. For centuries they practically ruled over what is now East Prussia and Lithuania, their principal station being Marienburg, while it was one of their grand masters who founded the Duchy of Prussia, the nucleus of the Hohenzollerr monarchy under the Polish crown.
