
Ask Board of Trade About Business Matters - Big Game Regulation.

ersons not domiciled in Canada, may be exported from St. John, McAdam unction, St. Stephen, and other Canadian points specially named. Exportation shall be permitted only within 15 tion shall be permitted only within 15 days after the open season allowed for shooting deer under the laws of the province or territory where the deer to be exported has been shot. No person shall in one year export more than the whole or parts of one moose and of three deer, nor shall exportation of such moose or deer be made by the same person on more than two occasions during one calendar year. Deer or parts thereof which have been killed in contravention of law shall not be exported. There are certain other cus-
