Right ear drum normal. Hearing at ear CV 5'.
Left ear drum scarred a bit hearing CV 10'.
In testing only hears bone conduction if very intense and hearing even lower than above which I am inclined to think is more to his actual state. Nose and Throat negative.
This man has a nerve deafness probably better classed in this case as a mixed deafness on account of some evidence of former ear trouble. Given H-4 grading. It is felt this is quite a handicap in most any form of duty. I can find little evidence in history to indicate a cause, and am inclined to think it has been a gradual process.
Suggest grading H-4 mixed deafness. If there seems to be evidence of progression in this case or too much disability for duty he may be re-considered for discharge if though necessary at any time.
