FIRST DAY OF THE EXHIBITION WAS MOST SUCCESSFUL.

Seven Thousand Five Hundred Persons Passed Through the Gates.

Yesterday's attendance was most satisfactory, reaching the high figure, for the first day, of 7,516. This will be more than doubled today, as the crowds from outside points will make their presence felt in goodly numbers.

The band of the 5th Battalion, Royal Garrison regiment, which was the principal musical attraction at the exhibition, arrived in the city yesterday morning, and gave its first concert on the grounds in front of amusement hall in the early afternoon in the presence of a small gathering of delighted listeners. The band fully sustained its reputation for special ability to cater to all tastes. Bandmaster W. F. Cooper is a veteran leader who knows how to handle his men. Commencing today, this band will give two concerts daily till the close of the exhibition, hours 2 p. m. and 7:30.

The attendance at night was more than sufficient to make glad the hearts of the management, and to demonstrate that the residents of St. John were animated by a desire to make the exhibition the best patronized in St. John's history. For fully two hours the turnstiles were kept merrily clicking, and by 8 o'clock the main buildings were well filled in part, while thousands wandered their way to the other buildings, chiefly, however, to the two amusement halls. The City Council had given an excellent concert in the open in front of the grand stand. The vaudeville performance in amusement hall, Segments Adge and the trained lions, and other features were liberally patronized by delighted audiences, while the Meisler Glee Club had a more liberal patronage than was expected in the afternoon. At 8:30 p. m. the 5th R. G. R. band gave another concert in the industrial building, and the intense pleasure of thronged floors and galleries. This band has jumped into instant favor. Owing to the noise created by the crowds that passed up and down, the stairs to the amusement hall, the lectures announced to be given during the evening in the Farmers' Pavilion by J. M. Garboush of Western Ontario, on "The desirable points in a Draught Horse," and on "Cattle Raising," by Duncan Anderson of Rugby, Ontario, had to be postponed to a later date.

THE FIREWORKS DISPLAY.

It was ten minutes past ten when Mr. Hand fired his signal bomb, and there was an instant rush to the main buildings and all the subsidiary departments to the centre of the Barwick square. The 10 minutes of the display, the best view patronized the reserved seats on the grand stand, while the masses crowded around the wire fence that enclosed the horse ring, where they saw all they wanted to see. Taken as a whole, the display was a good one, the colors being particularly brilliant and the rockets extremely high in their flights. The set pieces, while not numerous, were attractive, and the bombardment of Fort Arthur was full of noise, smoke, the booming of artillery, and the sharp rattle of musketry. It was realistic enough to keep the crowd standing till the last shot had been fired and the last fort had exploded.

ON THE PIKE.

The Pike of the Exhibition is earning its name. In dictionaries "pike" is defined as a genus of fish, and, indeed, the Pike of the Exhibition is a veritable fishing ground. The promoters of the side show and the proprietors of the games of chance are fishing in the nickles, dimes and quarters, and a certain class of people are being caught like fish. With some of the side shows no fair minded person could find fault. They are fully worth the small admission of a dime charged. The "laughing show" might be instanced as one which amply compensates the person curious enough to pay the fee and see it. "It" is nothing else than comical, mirth-provoking reflections of the person himself in six mirrors before which he passes. He, indeed, would be a source of merriment, who could remain unmoved in the face of the game of chance, and the sharp rattle of an instant in the lines of an air-fried spectre. Passing on, an Irishman, a wild man of Borneo. No one enters who finds the open air he is fairly splitting his sides with hilarity.

Treading to the opposite side of the pike the visitor sees a very different picture. Selecting any one of the numberless chance (or no chance) stands he finds a number of men seriously, almost grimly, bent on making their little "pile" of money. They stake their dime or their quarter in the hope of making fifty cents or a dollar. They sometimes win; as a rule they lose. One of these stands is termed "Kull Football," a name which many of the fished ones will doubtless upon reflection consider strikingly appropriate, if not personal.

One of these stands of chance was thought by the ignorant on-looker to be about as much as the manager had succeeded apparently in arousing the curiosity of about twenty gentlemen with a little cash. The game was simple enough, being nothing more than the tossing of a ball upon an oblique surface dotted with rows of pegs, the ball rolling down until it reached a board marked in different places "one box" and "one cigar." The ball stopped in at "one box," the winner received either a box of cigars or its value, a dollar. A quarter of a dollar was the stake. The manager had been losing right along, until he became so reckless as to offer, first, for a quarter, then three, and finally

five. Each time he lost, but, like a man, promptly paid up. To the twenty participants or more in the play he must have paid over one hundred dollars, and still he seemed anxious to continue the game. The game became so intensely interesting that some of those who before were mere spectators searched their pockets for a quarter and joined the circle. It was then that the tide of fortune turned in favor of the manager and he didn't stop winning until he had fished the pockets of those who latterly joined the game.

NO FREE SEATS.

There are no free seats at the exhibition this year. If a person is not he has got to pay ten cents for a seat, or remain tired. At the last exhibition there was nothing like this. Then the seats overlooking the bandstand in the main building were free. Now, however, these very same seats have been fenced in and valued at ten cents each. Many complaints were heard yesterday afternoon and evening from elderly persons who were unable to obtain a seat.

AGRICULTURAL HALL.

The exhibits in the agricultural hall are as yet incomplete in one or two lines, but today all the entries will be on hand. The northern end of the first floor is given up entirely to dairy products and some fine specimens of cheese and butter have been received. Space has been reserved for the competitions in cheese and butter making and these will be held as usual. Near this end are the exhibits of several cream separator concerns, and the attendants are kept busy explaining the parts and the workings of their patented machines.

The Clydesdale and the Anglo-Saxon Stock Food Co. each have excellent exhibits of their products, while beyond them is the booth of International Food Company, represented in this city by H. S. Wallace. Passing along on the left hand side we come to the fruit department. This has an extremely fine lot displayed on its shelves and is well worth a close inspection, if only to see what good fruit can be grown in New Brunswick. Entries have also been received from all the exhibitors of this department. Fruit consists of apples, but some fine lines of pears and plums are also shown. Two very fine displays are made by Messrs. Harrison and W. M. Thurett, both of Margerville. The big varieties of pumpkins and squashes are much again in evidence this year. Native grown musk and watermelons are also shown.

MARITIME EXPERIMENTAL FARM.

The trophy of the Maritime Experimental Farm at Nappan, N. S., is one

of the best features of the agricultural hall. Grains, fruits, roots, etc., are tastefully arranged in ornamental style, set off by photographic views of the farm and its main buildings. An interesting part of the display is the cards giving the result of the experiments made with respect to determining what are the best and most reliable varieties for farmers to cultivate in the various department of field orchard and garden. POULTRY HALL.

A visit to the poultry hall reveals a fine collection of birds. Mr. Campbell of Canis, an established authority on the poultry line, told the Sun reporter that he considered the collection fully equal in numbers to and considerably better in quality than the exhibits in this line made here two years ago. Much improvement has been made in the direction of the poultry line, and the exhibitors have been banished from the hall never to return and in their stead have been ready to explain the merits and good features of the pick of the collection.
