WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitobe, Saakas-hean or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be mades at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency), on certain conditions.

Duties — Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homesteader and live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 60 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in rood starting may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead.
