

Meeting of Local Council of Women

Members Assembled at Residence of Mrs. W. B. Tennant Last Evening—Matters of Health and Public Welfare Discussed.

An evening of enjoyment and instruction was spent by members of the Local Council of Women who met at the residence of Mrs. W. B. Tennant, Orange street, last night. Mrs. E. Albertson Smith presided, and the first business taken up was the reading of a communication from A. M. Heald, asking for the help of the Council for the Children's Aid, and the report of Mrs. W. F. B. Patterson on the drinking fountain.

Regarding the fountain, Mrs. Patterson reported that Commissioner Fisher and the City Engineer were willing to fall in with the wishes of the Council, but strongly advised against setting the fountain until the spring. Mrs. E. A. Young said that all the objections against its present erection were reasonable, and she felt that this decision should be respected.

Mrs. Smith reported on an interview held with Premier Foster, who had said to Mrs. Hatheway and herself that there are no vacancies on the present board of Motion Picture Censors, and that he was satisfied that the Board were doing their work well. If a vacancy occurred, consideration would be given the recommendation of the Women's Council.

Mrs. Smith also reported on an interview with Hon. Dr. Roberts, when he explained to Mrs. Smith and Mrs. David McLellan the co-ordination of societies. Mrs. McLellan will represent the Council provincially on this bureau of information, and another member of the Council will be appointed locally.

RETIREMENT OF JOSEPH FLAVELLE IS CONFIRMED

Disposes of His Stock in the William Davies Company for \$3,000,000.

Toronto, Nov. 27.—The William Davies Company announced today the retirement of Sir Joseph Flavelle from the company of which he was president, and in which he controlled fifty-two per cent of the stock. This stock passes into the hands of E. C. Fox, general manager, and a group of associates.

The figure at which Sir Joseph sold is said to be \$3,000,000. He became general manager of the company in 1892 and continued until 1912, when he became president of the reorganized company and was followed into the management by E. C. Fox, a grandson of the late Wm. Davies.
