CHAPTER I.

LETTER I.—VOYAGE TO NEW BRUNSWICK.

On board the Ship —, July 24th, 1851.

MY DEAREST —

LIKE that illustrious traveller Lord Bateman,

I shipped myself all aboard of a ship,
Some foreign country for to see,

and once more found myself a wanderer over the world,
though scarce three months had elapsed since my return
from a seven years' banishment from England. Last
July I believed myself tied for many a year to come to
the bush of Australia; last February I was in the grasp
