the maintenance of the supplies of white fish and other kinds of fish in this section of the county, and desire to express our belief in the benefits which are derivable, and have been realized from the large number of young white fish and pickerel which have been bred and turned out from the Government fish hatchery at Sandwich, on the Detroit River. And further, we do believe that the Government, in its wisdom, is looking to the interests of the people of this section of the county in the maintenance of the said hatchery.
