BILL.

An Act to detach a certain tract of land from the Midland District and to annex it to the District of Bathurst.

HEREAS from the peculiar position Preamble. of the tract of land hereinafter mentioned, its inhabitants cannot without great inconvenience and expense attend the Courts 5 in the Midland District, to which it now belongs, but could much more conveniently attend those held in the District of Bathurst: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of 10 the same, That all that tract of land lying to Accretain tract the north west of the townships of Palmers-detached from the Midland ton and Clarendon, in the Midland District, District and and between the said Townships and the Ot- District of Batawa River, and bounded on one side towards thurst. 15 the north east by the present line of the District of Bathurst, and on the other side towards the south west by a line drawn parellel to the general course of the line last mentioned, from the western corner of the 20 said Township of Clarendon to the Ottawa River, shall be and the said tract of land is bereby detached from the Midland District. and shall hereafter form part of the District of Bathurst; Provided always, that all 25 suits, actions, prosecutions or proceedings of any kind commenced before the passing of this Act, shall be continued and proceeded in, and execution shall be done therein as if this Act had not been passed.
