With reference to your letter of the 3rd May last I have to inform you that Sec. 7, S.W. 16, Secs. 17 and 18, S. 19, and all Sec. 20, in Tp. 54-5-W.3.M., were transferred to the Province of Saskatchewan by the Department of the Interior under Order in Council, P.C. 391, dated 16th February 1935, and I have received advice from the Provincial Director of Lands that these lands have been disposed of under long term grazing lease to the University of Saskatchewan. It is suggested that you correspond with the University authorities with a view to ascertaining if, under the circumstances, they would consider granting permits to the Indians as was formerly done by the Department of National Defence.
