them. It is therefore nightly important that the employee shoese with the utmost care the one of their manber in whom they have most confidence.

In order that the greatest freedom may be given the men in making their selection, it is bereby expressly provided that Superintendents and l'it Bosses shall not attend, and that none other than wage carners in the Sompany's employ shall be ortitled to be present and vote in the choice of a representative.

The mosting is free to choose its own Chairman, whose duty it will be to see that the purpose for which the meeting is called is duly carried out and to notify the management in writing of the name of the person selected as representative.
