of continuing or improving the present machinery for economic co-operation. It was understood that the report of such a Committee could not become effective until sometime in 1933, probably in the Autumn of that year, but that in the meantime the financial support of the Empire Marketing Board by the Government of the United Kingdom would not be withdrawn.

9. It was agreed that a Sub-Committee on Films and Radio be set up, including representatives from the Delegations desirous of participating in the discussion of those subjects.

10. The Committee adjourned at 1:00 p.m.
